FFE INDIA TRUST AT A GLANCE

About the Trust:	Promoted by Foundation For Excellence, Inc. (FFE USA) a tax exempt, publicly supported charitable organization based in Santa Clara, California, USA(www.ffe.org). Registered as a Public Charitable Trust in Bengaluru, Karnataka. Registered under u/s 12 A (a) of the IT Act, 1961. Registered under the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976.
Mission:	Bring about a transformation in the lives of academically bright and economically underprivileged students in India by enabling them to complete their higher education in India.
Program:	Provide scholarships to students pursuing studies in professional courses in Engineering, Technology and Medicine.
Eligibility:	Academic performance, family income and background.
Process:	Volunteers (facilitators) and institutions, pre-registered with the Trust, identify eligible students in India and provide assistance in submitting scholarship applications to the Trust. All FFE scholars who have graduated are encouraged to fulfill their “pledge” to support the education of at least 2 brilliant and needy students by making financial contributions to the Trust.
Results:	Since inception until 31 March 2012, 1328 students assisted. Rs. 6,78,47,732 disbursed as scholarships.
Donations:	Donations are accepted towards: (1) Corpus of the Trust; (2) General purposes of the Trust; (3) Adopt A Scholar Program”, earmarked funds for scholarships to students designated by state, gender and course of study; and (4) Towards the Scholarship Program Donations are eligible for tax deduction u/s 80G of the IT Act. Rs. 2,83,51,102 received as donations since inception to 31 March 2012 (excluding the grant from FFE Inc., USA), with Rs. 71,12,865 being contributions from FFE scholars.

FOUNDATION FOR EXCELLENCE INDIA TRUST

The Trustees of Foundation For Excellence India Trust are pleased to present the highlights of the work of the Trust for the year ended 31 March 2012.

From the start of FY 2010-11, FFE India Trust, Bengaluru has been responsible for the implementation of the Foundation For Excellence Inc. (FFE), USA's Scholarship Program in India. FFE has also been supporting the Trust in its marketing, promotion and fund raising efforts in India. The scope of the Trust's activities in India has expanded with a special impetus to gain visibility for the Trust in India, expand alumni outreach, and raise funds in India. FY 2011-12 saw an increased growth in the Trust's activities in these focus areas.

Scholarship Program

FFE India Trust awarded 1,686 scholarships amounting to Rs.3,87,93,327 during FY 2011-12 as compared to 1,146 scholarships for an amount of Rs.2,58,78,236 during FY 2010-11. FFE Inc. awarded a grant directly to the FCRA account of FFE India Trust for the second year. Of the 1,686 scholarships, 1,325 scholarships for an amount of Rs.3,03,15,362 were funded out of the grant provided by FFE Inc. USA; the remaining 361 scholarships amounting to Rs.84,77,965 were funded out of donations raised by the Trust.

Of the 1,686 scholarships approved during FY 2011-12, 544 were students beginning their first year of Engineering or Medical studies while 1,142 were renewal scholarships.

Details of scholarship disbursement to 1,686 students by state and gender is detailed in Annexure 1.

Management of FFE India Trust

Five meetings of the Board of Trustees were held during the year ended 31 March 2012; the first on 01 April 2011, followed by meetings on 10 May 2011, 05 July 2011, 06 September, 2011 and 06 December 2011.

Activities and Outreach

FFE India Trust held 5 events during FY 2011-2012 with the aim to connect and network with the FFE community of students, alumni, facilitators, volunteers, individual and corporate donors and community partners. FFE Open House events were held in Kolkata on 25 September, 2011, in Bengaluru on 16 October 2011, in Odisha on 13 November 2011, in Chennai on 29 January 2012, and in Ahmedabad on 19 February 2012. The events provided a platform for all stakeholders of FFE to meet and interact with FFE Founders, Dr. Prabhu and Poonam Goel and numerous industry and community leaders who support FFE. Prominent guests of honour at FFE events included Mr. Sanjiv Puri, Divisional Chief Executive, Tobacco, ITC Ltd, Professor Jahar Saha, Former Director, IIM Ahmedabad, and Mr. Debashis Sen, Senior IAS Officer and Principal Secretary, Urban Development, Government of West Bengal at the Open House

in Kolkata; Mr. Kris Gopalkrishnan, Executive Co-Chairman, Infosys at the Bengaluru Open House; Dr. J K Satpathy, Vice Chancellor of Biju Patnaik University of Technology (BPUT), Rourkela and Dr. P K Padhi, Principal, College of Engineering and Technology, Bhubaneswar at the Odisha Open House; and Mr. Lakshmi Narayanan, Vice Chairman, Cognizant Technology Solutions at the Chennai Open House.

The importance of building and nurturing the FFE community, encouraging alumni to contribute to FFE and the importance of networking were messages conveyed by FFE at these events. During the course of 2011-12, Trustees interacted and met with almost 1000 individual stakeholders of FFE. Scholars and alumni were encouraged to stay engaged with FFE during the course of their academic program and after completion of their courses. Alumni who distinguished themselves through their generous monetary contributions and through their services for FFE were honored at the Open House events. Additionally, alumni were awarded a Certificate of Excellence for completion of their academic program and were strongly encouraged to contribute to the growth of the Foundation. State Alumni Chapters were launched at these events, with a goal to engage students, alumni and volunteers and build the FFE community. A nationwide forum, with state chapters contributing at the national level is anticipated; of the 5 state Alumni Chapters, the Karnataka Alumni Chapter was most actively involved with FFE's growth during FY 2011-12.

The FFE Scholars' Association web portal, sa.ffe.org has been able to promote outreach with almost 1,000 FFE alumni registering through this portal. Registration at this web portal provides an opportunity for alumni to network socially and professionally, to collaborate on projects, to post job openings, to seek guidance from experienced professionals and to contribute to FFE's growth.

Donations to the Trust

The Trust received a grant of Rs.3,21,72,300 from FFE USA in FY 2011-12. In addition, the Trust raised donations amounting to Rs.1,21,26,589 as compared to Rs.81,54,917 in FY 2010-11. This included donations of Rs.23,03,516 from 285 scholars as compared to Rs.12,04,777 from 189 FFE Scholars during FY 2010-11, representing an increase in donations of 91%; of these, 131 alumni were new donors to the Trust. Corporate donations included Rs.5,00,000 from Robert Bosch Engineering and Business Solutions Limited, Bangalore, Rs.2,25,000 from Indication Instruments Ltd, Faridabad and Rs.5,00,000 from Easyaccess Financial Services Ltd., Chennai. An unrestricted grant of Rs.25,00,000 from India Value Fund Advisors Pvt. Ltd. was awarded to FFE for the second year, to be utilized to scale the work of the Foundation. Donations included Rs.5,69,265 to the Corpus of the Trust, Rs.32,09,302 to the General Fund, Rs.18,88,004 to the Scholarship Fund and Rs.64,60,018 to the "Adopt A Scholar" Program. Accounts

The accounts of the Trust for the year ended 31 March 2012 as audited by Shri G S Prakash, Chartered Accountant, are appended.

Excluding donations of Rs.5,69,265 to the Corpus, the Trust earned income of Rs.4,46,94,716 during the year. Of this amount, remittances from FFE, USA accounted for Rs.3,21,72,300, donations to the General Fund and the Scholarship Program accounted for Rs.1,15,57,324 and interest on investments and bank deposits for Rs.9,65,092. The Trust disbursed Rs.3,87,93,327 on scholarships and incurred Rs.41,38,399 as administrative expenses (excluding depreciation of Rs.64,790) with an excess of income over expenditure of Rs.16,98,200.

The Trustees would like to thank all donors for their generous support. The support extended by facilitators, coordinators and volunteers is also gratefully acknowledged.

The Trustees look forward to another year of expansion, learning and extended engagement and to your continued support.

- 1) The Trust has been registered under Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976 vide Registration Number 094421348.
- 2) The Trust has opened an FCRA Bank Account and all the foreign remittances are credited to this account.
- 3) During the current financial year, the Trust has received foreign Donations of ₹3,22,04,872/- from USA, comprising of remittances of ₹3,21,72,300/- from Foundation For Excellence Inc., USA and donations amounting to ₹24,268/- from Give India Foundation, USA and ₹8304/- from Intel Foundation USA. The Trust has also received Rupee Donations amounting to ₹1,15,24,752/- including ₹35,01,250/- from Give India.
- 4) During the year, the Total Scholarship Amount awarded was ₹3,87,93,327/- comprising of ₹3,03,15,362/- from the FCRA Account and ₹84,77,965/- from the Non-FCRA account.
- 5) Remuneration to staff and reimbursement of Cost of Travel by Board Members /Trustees is attached as Annexure "A"
- 6) Depreciation is calculated as per rates prescribed by Income-Tax Rules
- 7) It is the policy of the Assessee to prepare his Financial Statements on cash receipts and disbursements basis. On this basis, revenue and related assets are recognised when received rather than when earned and expenses are recognised when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred.
- 8) The Assessee does not have any liability towards Gratuity.
- 9) The Fixed Assets are disclosed at actual cost less depreciation.
- 10) Since the Assessee follows Cash System of accounting, revenue is recognised on receipt of income.
