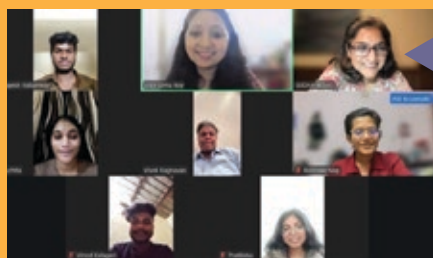

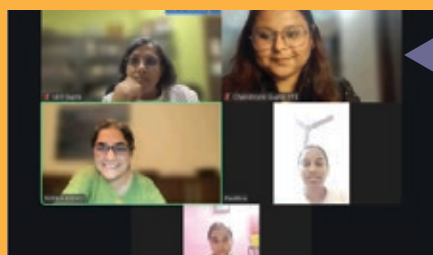

GOSUMEC donor-scholar interaction with Batch of 2024 I 19th November, 2025

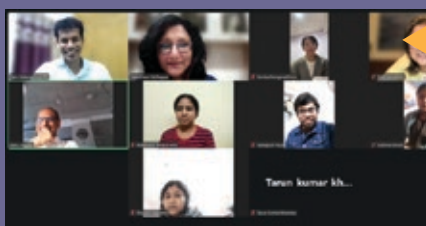


Moments from the GOSUMEC donor-scholar interaction, where GOSU-FFE scholars discussed peer-led initiatives to strengthen support for future cohorts

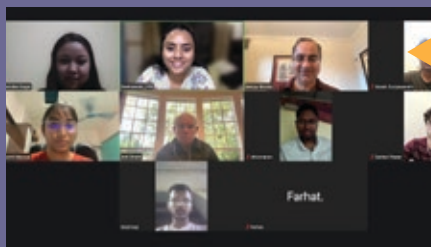


Scholars, alumni, and donors in an engaging virtual interaction focused on guidance and growth

GOSUMEC Donor Scholar Interaction with Batch of 2023 I 27th November, 2025



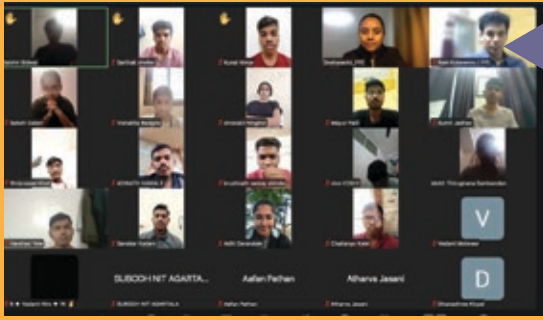

Donor Scholar Interaction-Bajaj Finserv Scholarship Program I 13th December, 2025



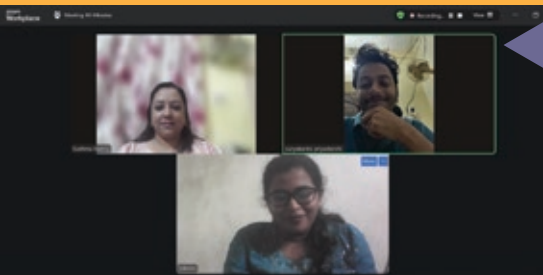
A snapshot from the donor-scholar interaction with Bajaj Finserv

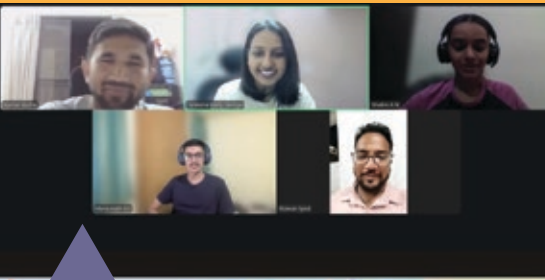
The interaction marked a strong first engagement between the donor and scholars, featuring lively discussions and positive feedback from both sides.

Strengthening Connections Through Alumni and Donor Engagement



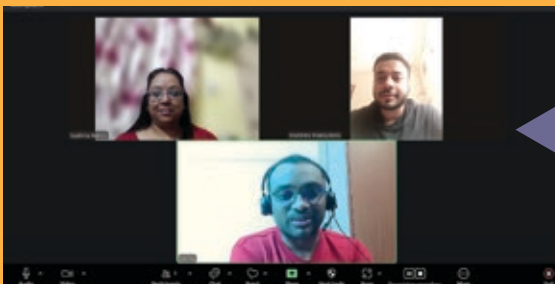

FFE and RIST Announce Rural Healthcare Initiative – A New Direction for Impact | 15th November, 2025

On **15th November, 2025**, Foundation For Excellence (FFE) and Rural India Supporting Trust (RIST) met in Delhi to advance a significant new collaboration—the FFE–RIST Rural Healthcare Bridging Program.

The meeting brought together leadership teams from both organisations to review early progress, discuss design elements and align on next steps, marking the beginning of a long-term effort to strengthen healthcare in India's rural regions.

This partnership reflects FFE's ongoing work to expand its impact beyond scholarships by aligning education support with a wider nation-building vision. The initiative focuses on a critical national challenge: although 65% of India's population lives in rural areas, only about 20% of doctors are available there, leaving many communities without timely medical care.

To address this gap, the program has two core components:

- **MBBS Scholarships for first-year medical students from rural, low-income households**
- **A Rural Fellowship Pilot that will support two batches of 25 FFE doctors to serve in rural health centres, with financial support, mentorship and PG-prep support**

The meeting with RIST's global team reinforced a shared commitment to ensure that student success also strengthen the communities they come from, by building a steady pool of doctors who are equipped and encouraged to work in rural India.

Opening Doors to Aerospace Innovation: FFE Scholars at Collins Aerospace | 18th November, 2025

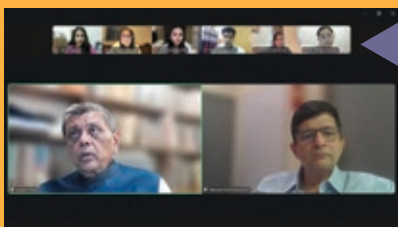
The students toured advanced engineering labs, interacted with passionate Collins volunteers, and attended insightful sessions led by

Constitution Day Webinar by Justice Gautam Patel | 26th November, 2025

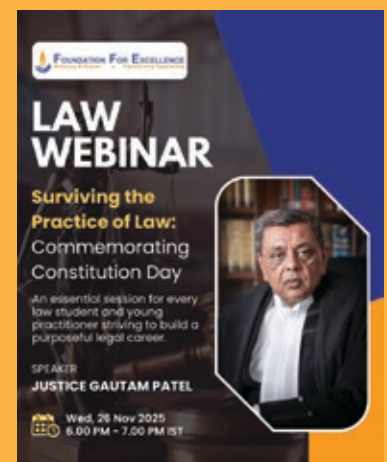


Justice Gautam Patel engaging with over 200 law students in a powerful Constitution Day webinar

NetApp Global Giving Challenge Non-Profit Fair | 10th December, 2025

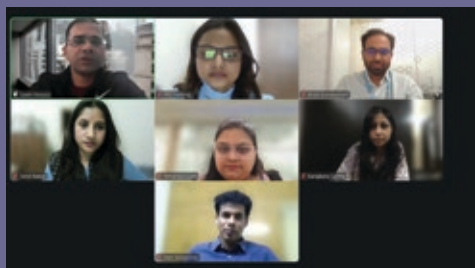

Lam Research Challenge 2025: Grand Finale at PES University, Bengaluru | 12th December, 2025

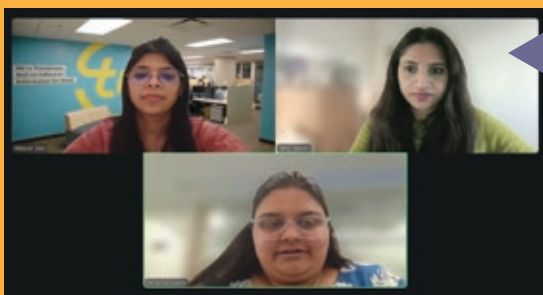

Building Career Readiness: Interview Etiquette Session for Scholars | 23rd December, 2025

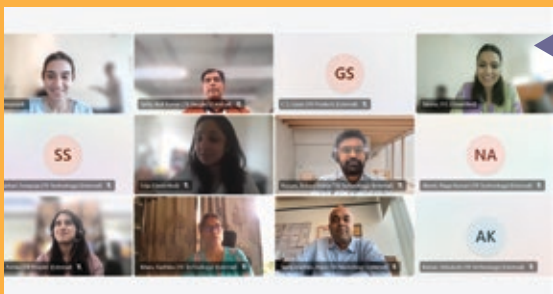


Scholars building confidence and interview-ready skills through an interactive career preparedness session

C. MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

The Mentoring program for Engineering students commenced in June 2025 and is expected to conclude in January 2026, where over **2400 Engineering mentees** have been paired with **Mentors** from over **59 Corporates**. Mentors include **40 Alumni** and **35 Individuals** from various corporates.

Synopsys Mentoring–Scholar Visit | 5th November, 2025

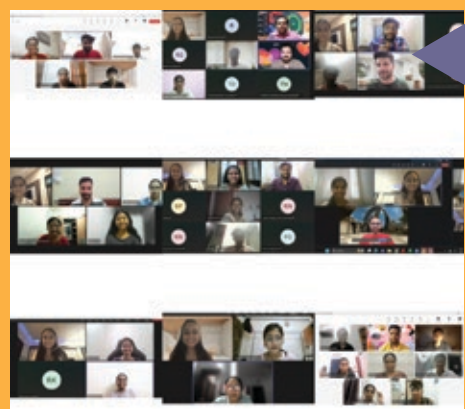

E. SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM



FFE's comprehensive skilling initiative continues to transform scholar readiness for the professional world by building strong communication, technical, and aspirational skills. What began in **2017** with just **two** courses has now grown into nearly **20** offerings, positively impacting over **12,000** scholars every year. This quarter, communication skills took center stage with multiple tailored English programs: **2,432** second-year scholars enrolled in the English Helper program supported by **Capgemini**; **1,103** third-year scholars began advanced **Hi Touch English** training backed by **MSDF**; and **85** final-year scholars launched a placement-focused communication program supported by Lenovo. Adding to this momentum, FFE piloted a new Spoken English program with **Orbit Skilling** for third-year scholars, emphasizing real-life communication and confidence-building, set to begin in December.

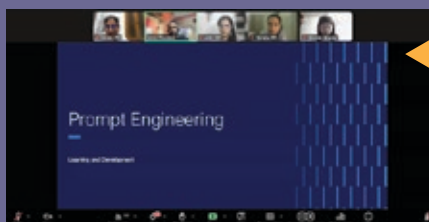
On the technical and aspirational front, FFE bridged academia and industry through high-impact partnerships and leadership initiatives. A total of **136** scholars enrolled in **NPTEL courses**, with **101** earning certifications, while **420** scholars joined the **LearnTube** technical skilling program. In collaboration with **Microsoft**, **1,600+** scholars were onboarded onto **19** Gen AI courses via a dedicated LMS, and over **2,100** third-year scholars began industry-relevant Coursera programs for FY25. Leadership and wellbeing were equally prioritized: **538** scholars participated in the "**Finding the Leader in You**" workshop, **2,005** engaged in wellness sessions, and **300+** scholars benefited from the **Harvard-led Aspire Leaders Program** across three cohorts. Complementing this, FFE and Mpower delivered impactful focus group sessions on self-esteem, digital wellbeing, and assertive communication facilitated by Psychologist **Payel Chakraborty**—ensuring scholars grow not only as professionals, but as confident, resilient individuals ready to lead in a competitive world.

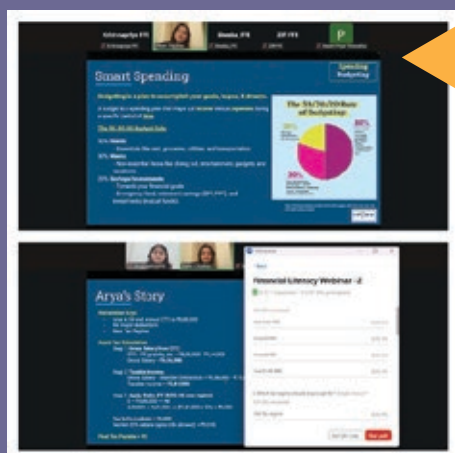

Narayanan Ulaganathan grew up in Thoothukudi, Tamil Nadu, in a lower middle-class family where education was deeply valued despite financial constraints. His father worked as an LIC agent, and his mother managed the household, ensuring stability and support for the family. With long working hours and limited resources, his parents made sustained sacrifices to educate their two children, believing firmly in the power of learning. Narayanan attended a private, English-medium school, which helped shape his academic foundation and aspirations. He shares a close bond with his sister, who is now a Senior Data Analyst at LatentView Analytics, and together, their journeys reflect the family's commitment to education as a pathway to progress.

In 2011, Narayanan secured admission to the Madras Institute of Technology, Anna University, a dream achievement that also brought new challenges. The cost of boarding and commuting in Chennai felt overwhelming until he learned about Foundation For Excellence through his university. The FFE scholarship proved to be life-changing, easing the family's financial burden and allowing Narayanan to focus entirely on his studies. After graduating in 2015, Narayanan began his career as a Software Engineer at Zoho. One of his earliest milestones was supporting his sister's undergraduate education (2016–2019) entirely through his own earnings, without loans or scholarships. This marked the beginning of his journey of giving back. He soon transitioned from being a volunteer to a FFE donor.

During his tenure at CRED (2020–2024), Narayanan volunteered his professional expertise to support off-campus placement initiatives for FFE scholars. Since last year, he has taken an even more meaningful step by partially sponsoring and adopting a scholar—completing what he calls a “full circle.”

Narayanan attributes much of his professional success to FFE's holistic support system. Mentorship from FFE alumnus **Srivathsan Raghavan** during his pre-final and final years, guidance from his university senior and donor, **Mr. Meenakshisundaram**, and support from facilitators **Mrs. Usha Balaji** and **Mrs. Jaya Krishnaswamy** played a crucial role in shaping his career and confidence. These relationships continue to guide him even today. One moment remains etched in his memory. When Narayanan once asked his sponsor how he could repay the support he had received, the response was simple yet profound: **“Give it back to society. Give it back to FFE.”** This mantra continues to guide him as he pays forward the opportunity that transformed not just his life, but his family's future as well.

Dr. S. Ganesan
(FFE Scholar/ Alumnus

As he completes nearly 25 years of association with FFE, Dr. S. Ganesan's journey comes full circle - from a young scholar with big dreams to a committed facilitator and national scientist.

Dr. Ganesan completed his Class 12 in 2001 at Government higher secondary school, Jedarpalayam which is in Namakkal district of Tamil Nadu. He secured admission to Mechanical Engineering at the

National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli (then REC Trichy). Coming from a humble background as the son of a handloom weaver, studying at a premier engineering institution once felt unimaginable. After sharing his financial constraints with friends and well-wishers, he was connected to FFE through a facilitator. This marked the beginning of a rigorous selection and verification process, involving multiple visits to Chennai to meet his facilitator and complete documentation and assessments. The journey began with a simple fax sent to his village post office—inviting him to Chennai for a meeting that would ultimately alter the course of his life.

After graduating in 2005, Dr. Ganesan was selected by Thermax and later by Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO). Choosing national service, he joined DRDO and today brings 20 years of experience in designing solid rocket systems for India's defence missile programmes. He has contributed to strategic missions including Akash Missile and BrahMos, systems that played a crucial role during Operation Sindhoor.

Alongside his professional journey, he completed his Master's and Ph.D. in Aerospace Engineering from Indian Institute of Technology Madras. He fondly recalls visiting FFE's Mumbai office in 2006 and leaving behind a handwritten note with his scholar ID, hoping the team would know that one more FFE scholar had "made it."

Since joining DRDO, Dr. Ganesan has been a proud FFE donor and facilitator. The mentorship he received as a scholar left a lasting impact, shaping his values and inspiring him to give back. Over the years, he has identified, conducted family background verification checks and guided almost 250 FFE scholars, particularly from rural Tamil Nadu. Interacting with students who have faced immense hardships, especially during the COVID years, continues to motivate his commitment to the cause. As a long-time facilitator and partner in FFE's mission, Dr. Ganesan offers a thoughtful perspective for the future: support fewer students, but support them fully.

He strongly believes that mentorship must remain central to the FFE model, as it builds lasting connection, gratitude, and a culture of giving back. As FFE grows, he advocates for the depth, quality, and holistic support for every scholar.

Dr. Ganesan shares these reflections not as critique, but as gratitude in action. "My life was transformed because of FFE," he says, "and it is my responsibility to help ensure that future scholars receive the same life-changing support."



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
